The following classes are now open for registration:

Mishpacha Sheli (*No Temple Membership Required*)

“My Family” is a new program designed for pre-kindergarten aged children and their parents who would like a family education experience. The program offers an introduction to Jewish values, holidays and customs through singing, storytelling, art, movement and games. This class will meet once a month for 8 sessions from 10:15 am to 12:30 pm. Kindergarten (*Temple Membership Required*)

The core of the Jewish Studies program begins in this class, where students will explore the Jewish holidays and the meaning of T'fillah (prayers) at an age appropriate level. They are also introduced to the world of Torah, mitzvot, ritual practices, tzedakah, and Jewish ethical values. Kindergarten has a special focus on Shabbat. This class meets each Sunday from 10:15 am to 12:30 pm. The first day of school is September 13, 2009.

Students must be 5 years old by December 2, 2009.

In addition to the sessions listed above, you will also be invited to participate in a number of school-wide events throughout the year, including holiday celebrations, mitzvah projects, and fundraisers. We invite you to become engaged with our school and Temple and see how many wonderful opportunities are available for involvement with our community.
